COVID-19 SAFETY RULES

WE ARE EXCITED TO WELCOME YOU BACK TO MICRO ICE! WE TAKE OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO KEEP YOU SAFE VERY SERIOUSLY. PLEASE HELP US BY READING AND FOLLOWING THESE IMPORTANT RULES.

- ✓ Participants and parents/guardians entering Micro Ice must be free of any COVID-19 symptoms and must not have been in close contact with any person known to have COVID-19 within the preceding two weeks.
- ✓ Participants and parents/guardians should arrive no more than 10 minutes prior to session time and be dressed in advance of arrival, other than skates and helmets. When attending to skates and helmets, participants and parents/guardians should do so social distancing at least 6 feet away from others.
- ✓ Facility capacity is limited. Only one (1) parent/guardian may enter the facility with the participant if needed. Non-participating family and friends should not enter Micro Ice.
- ✓ We provide hand washing/sanitizing capabilities, but we also encourage participants and parents/guardians to have their own self-protection supplies such as masks and hand sanitizer.
- ✓ Everyone MUST be wearing a mask at all times. Participants may remove masks ONLY when on the ice.
- ✓ Please no congregating in the lobby, locker rooms or bathrooms. Participants must remain socially distant while waiting for the session to start. ABSOLUTELY NO HORSE PLAY WILL BE TOLERATED.
- ✓ A participant's parent/guardian may watch the session so long as social distancing of at least 6 feet is possible. If social distancing of at least 6 feet is not possible, parents/guardians should wait outside or in their cars.
- ✓ Bring your own water, clearly marked with your name. Please do not share water bottles.
- ✓ Participants and parents/guardians must leave the facility within 10 minutes of the end of the session. Participants should only remove skates and helmets inside the facility before departing. When removing skates and helmets, participants and parents/guardians should do so social distancing at least 6 feet away from others.
- ✓ The facility will be cleaned and sanitized regularly, especially high-touch areas. Please help us maintain a clean facility by not leaving any items or trash behind, and minimizing all touching of common areas.
