### Program Director

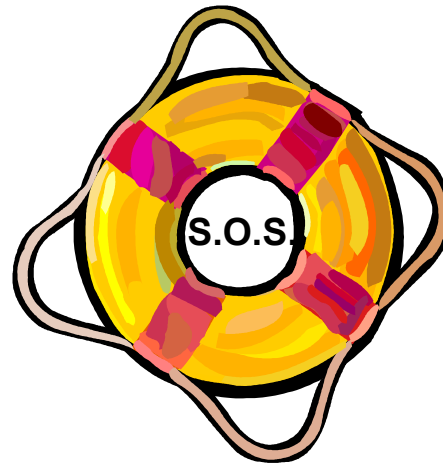

## School's Out Summer Program

Get Youth Moving, LLC is proud to present its School's Out Summer Program for 2015. The S.O.S. program will save your child/ren from the same 'ol boring summer routine. School's Out Summer Program will engage your child/ren in various adventurous activities. The S.O.S. Program is split into three groups:

- **Mini Mates** ages 3-6
- **Sea Dogs** entering K-6 grades
- **Middle School Crew** entering grades 7-9

The location of the School's Out Summer Program will be at the Greater Lawrence Technical School (GLTS) at 57 River Road in Andover. We will have use of three classrooms, the pool, the gym, the tennis courts and the fields. The dates of the summer program are June 29 through August 14. The daily schedule will include free choice, group games and sports, arts and crafts, clubs, swimming, tennis and weekly field trips.

New to S.O.S. this summer is the C.O.V.E. (Career Opportunities Via Exploration) Program. It will be available to registered Sea Dogs and Middle School Crew ages 10-15. A sampling of vocations will be offered including Carpentry, Graphic Design, Culinary Arts, Cosmetology and Automotive Technology. More detailed information will be available on the website once the C.O.V.E. Program Schedule has been established with the teachers at GLTS.

Get Youth Moving, LLC is required by the Andover Board of Health to be licensed as a camp in Massachusetts. There are many regulations and forms that I must abide by and complete to receive this license. Your cooperation with filling out these forms in a timely fashion is greatly appreciated.

Mini Mates is a play based, no pressure program in which our youngest participants will engage in a wide variety of age appropriate, themed activities. Mini Mates will run in conjunction with the Sea Dogs and Middle School Crew Programs. The program provides children the opportunity to socialize and function in a group setting, experience the excitement of meeting new friends, gain self-confidence and learn to respect others.

### Middle School Crew

*Entering grades 7-9*

*8:30 am - 4:30 pm (extended hours available)*

*limit 20 per week, GLTS*

The Middle School Crew is a counselor-in-training program where students entering 7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> grades are taught childcare skills and are exposed to leadership opportunities and a solid work ethic model. The Crew's responsibilities will include assisting the S.O.S. staff with activities throughout the day, creating and running weekly clubs, playing games with younger children, and assisting staff with groups of children on field trips. Registered Crew members must fill out a questionnaire and will be contacted by the director before camp begins.

### Sea Dogs

*Entering grades K-6*

Sea Dogs is an enrichment and recreational program for children entering grades K-6. Children participate in a wide variety of age-appropriate activities including tennis, drama, swimming, sports, arts & crafts, and weekly field trips.
